- **Question 1: Lincoln and the** *Gettysburg Address* 1 : Agrees or disagrees with a reason.
- 1: Who is included in the 'all men' created equal?
- 1 : Some discussion of what equality means.
- 1: Clarity of writing.

Question 2: Sumner and What the Social Classes Owe to Each Other

- 1: Understands meaning in context of argument.
- 1 : Has some evaluation (i.e. 'is coherent,' 'I agree,' etc.)
- 1: Links to historical or political thought in the era.
- 1: Mentions connection to Social Darwinism.

Question 3: W.E.B. Dubois on Harlan's dissent in Plessy v. Ferguson

- 1 : Agree in part: Similarity between the veil and badge of slavery.
- 1: Disagree in part: i.e. questions whether the constitution was color-blind or mentions 3/5 compromise
- 1: Notes Dubois would probably not accept Harlan's comments about racial superiority.
- 1 : Student critically engages Dubois' view in their own voice.
